Dear Minister,

I am pleased to submit a copy of the HEA's annual report and accounts for 2013.

In the general overview, the Report notes that 2013 was an historic year in the development of Irish higher education with considerable progress made in the implementation of the National Strategy for Higher Education.

In the overview we also highlight the deteriorating financial circumstances of the sector as a whole and of individual higher education institutions, at a time of increased demand for access. The HEA consider the future funding of higher education to be the major issue of strategic importance now outstanding for higher education and we welcome the fact that you are considering how this complex issue can be dealt with in a comprehensive, whole of Government way.

In accordance with section 13.1 of the Code of Practice for the Governance of State Bodies I wish to report to you on the Authority's compliance with the code, and specifically on the following matters:

- There were no events of commercial significance during the reporting period. However, the Authority is conscious of, and responding fully to, the changed economic climate, in particular by seeking efficiency gains both in its own operations and throughout the higher education system. It is also conscious of and acting on the need for closer monitoring of the financial performance of the institutions and as outlined above this has proven to be effective.
- The HEA's financial accounts for 2013 together with the certificate of the Comptroller and Auditor General are included in this report.
- On behalf of the Higher Education Authority I acknowledge our responsibility for ensuring that an effective system of internal financial control is maintained and operated. The Authority, some years ago, appointed an audit committee and put in place an internal audit function.

- While recognising that a system of internal financial controls can only provide reasonable and not absolute assurance that assets are safeguarded, transactions authorised and properly recorded, and that material errors or irregularities are either prevented or would be detected in a timely period, the Authority has endeavoured to put in place measures to ensure that an appropriate control environment operates in the HEA. These will be detailed in the statement of the system of internal financial controls which forms part of the audited accounts. The HEA's internal auditors carried out a review of the HEA's internal controls in July 2013 and August 2014.
- The HEA has adopted a code of business conduct for Members of the Authority and for its employees. The code for Members was reviewed and updated in March 2010. The Authority undertook an evaluation of its performance in 2009 and a further review on governance was completed in October 2012. Members undertook an effectiveness evaluation review in January 2014.
- The HEA complies with government remuneration guidelines. Members' fees are in accordance with rates sanctioned by the Department as are salaries and allowances paid to staff. The HEA applies the One Person, One Salary circular issued by the Department of Public Expenditure and Reform.
- The HEA has no post balance sheet events to report.
- The HEA has a procurement policy that is compliant with Department of Public Expenditure and Reform guidelines. The HEA subscribes to a number of National Procurement Service framework agreements.
- The HEA has a travel policy that is compliant with Department of Public Expenditure and Reform guidelines.
- The HEA currently has no capital expenditure proposals.

The HEA would be happy to provide any further clarification you require in relation to any of the above.

I would like to thank you and your officials in the Department for the assistance given in securing approval for a number of additional posts for the Executive. I fully appreciate how unusual such a decision is in the current climate. I would also like to pay tribute to two members who left the Authority during 2013, Ms Kathleen Lough and Mr John Logue.

I, together with the Authority and its executive, look forward to continuing to work with you and your Department, in particular on implementation of the Government's decisions last year on the higher education landscape configuration and system performance framework.

Annual Report of the Higher Education Authority for 2013

General overview

2013 marked a significant year in the history of Irish higher education, with clear progress on a number of fronts in implementing the recommendations set out in the National Strategy for Higher Education. The key recommendations related to the creation of a more co-ordinated system of mission specific higher education institutions and a new relationship between the sector and the Government, focussing more on the outcomes from the sector, by reference to stated national objectives with, in future years, funding tied to performance. The process for achieving these objectives, strategic dialogue, was commenced with submissions from the institutions, review involving national and international experts and meetings with each of the institutions leading to the agreement of compacts (completed in January 2014). The process was characterised by a very high level of engagement from the institutions, indicating an openness in the sector to far-reaching reform and enhanced accountability. The process has also brought a new level accountability to the HEA, with a responsibility to report annually on the performance of the higher education system.

The reform programme got fully underway in a very difficult financial environment for the sector with a further cut in recurrent funding by c. 7% and the continuing impact of the employment control framework on staffing levels. Notwithstanding these challenges most institutions achieved a growth in student numbers and continued to contribute to labour market activation measures. They also achieved a breakeven outturn financially, but as the year ended there were clear signs of strain across the sector with a small number of institutions operating with underlying deficits.

Structure of this Report

Part 1 of this report reviews 2013 by reference to the objectives set out in the Strategic Plan of the HEA. Part 2 addresses developments in a number of other, related key areas of activity in 2013. Part 3 provides information relating to HEA governance.

PART 1

Assessment of Outcomes Achieved in 2013

The HEA has six strategic objectives and required outcomes for the higher education system are specified under each of these six strategic objectives. The attainment of these outcomes is the ultimate yardstick against which the performance of the HEA is evaluated. 2013 delivered some headline achievements that are progressing the attainment of these outcomes. These overarching achievements are set out below and the implications for the work plan in 2014 are identified where appropriate.

Strategic Objective 1

System Development

This strategic objective is concerned with achieving a coherent system of higher education that is optimally structured and governed and that delivers improved performance to achieve the national objectives as set out by Government. Significant progress was made in 2013. Specifically -


- The HEA presented a report to the Minister for Education and Skills on system reconfiguration, inter-institutional collaboration and system governance in April 2013. The Minister's response in May 2013 provided the green light for a major programme of structural reform and a new relationship between the State and HEIs. Implementation commenced in the second half of 2013 and will continue to be at the cornerstone of the HEA's work plan throughout 2014.
- Strategic Dialogue formally became part of the higher education system in 2013. It has created a new mandate for the HEA by bringing a much sharper focus on HEI performance and HEI accountability for performance. It also creates a new accountability role for the HEA as the HEA is reporting to the Minister on the performance of the higher education system as a whole. The following were the key milestones in 2013:
 - The HEA provided advice in the landscape report to the Department of Education and Skills (DES) on national higher education system objectives and further consultations also took place with the DES on these objectives and system indicators. This resulted in the DES publishing the performance framework for the system.
 - Detailed templates and associated guidelines for HEI performance compacts with the HEA were prepared and published.
 - A national and international panel to assist in evaluating draft performance compacts from HEIs was established.
 - A call for submissions was made and proposed performance compacts were received from the HEIs and subsequently evaluated using the expertise of the assembled panel.
 - Comprehensive Strategic Dialogue meetings took place (December 2013 and continued through to January 2014) with all of the HEIs leading to the finalisation of performance compacts and the agreement of performance objectives with each HEI.
 - The strategic dialogue process is also establishing and evaluating the steps that the relevant institutions are taking to form the regional clusters and to establish joint approaches to key issues such as academic planning and access routes. Also following completion of the strategic dialogue meetings in January the HEA will prepare the first system performance review report for submission to the Minister for Education and Skills in the first quarter of 2014.
 - Following publication of the Teacher Education Review the HEA has been working with HEIs to progress implementation and very good progress has been made towards the establishment of several of the proposed new centres.
- The HEA provided advice to the DES Expert Apprenticeship Review Group and many of the HEA recommendations have been incorporated into the group's final report which is being considered by the Minister.

Strategic Objective 2

Sustainability of Higher Education

The primary outcome under this strategic objective is a higher education system that is funded sustainably on the basis of performance against national outcomes. Key achievements in 2013 were:

- Developments and adjustments were applied to the funding model to support the implementation of National Strategy and associated national outcomes. The funding model for the IoTs was amended to remove the funding disincentive in respect of the development of level 6 and 7 courses. The inclusion of distance education/off campus students in the universities funding model commenced. In addition, the first tranche of Strategic Innovation and Development Fund (SIDF) allocations were made specifically targeting National Strategy implementation objectives.
- Balanced budgets were agreed with the majority of HEIs and there was, and is, on-going engagement with those HEIs with underlying deficits.
- Substantial work took place regarding the development of a sustainability strategy. The work focussed heavily on how current resources can be better deployed and the management and operation tools needed by HEIs. This was in line with the Minister's expressed wishes. Towards the end of the year the Department indicated that they wished to have a broader study done and are to set out terms of reference. This work will therefore be continued into 2014.




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Strategic Objective 3

Policy and Planning



Under this objective the HEA seeks to effectively anticipate trends in higher education development nationally and internationally and also to enhance the data/evidence base that supports our policy advice to the Minister for Education and Skills.

- The organisation of the Irish EU Presidency international conference, 'Rankings and the Visibility of Quality Outcomes in the European Higher Education Area', held in Dublin Castle in January 2013. This was the key higher education event of the Irish Presidency of the Council of the European Union (2013), which provided an opportunity for dialogue among stakeholders from across Europe and beyond on how performance evaluation in higher education can best support the advancement of the mission and strategic priorities of the sector.
- The first sectoral performance evaluation report for Irish higher education, Towards a Performance Evaluation Framework: Profiling Irish Higher Education, was published. Presenting profiles of each publicly funded HEI, the report sets out an initial performance evaluation framework for the sector which will support institutions in their strategic performance management, and the formation of the coherent higher education system envisaged in the National Strategy. Focusing on the three dimensions of the core mission of higher education—teaching and learning, research, and engagement—the institutional profiles will be developed on an annual basis, facilitating the monitoring of trends in terms of student numbers, fields of study, participation metrics, and financial and human resources.

Strategic Objective 4

Governance of Higher Education

This objective is directed at achieving an appropriate governance/regulatory relationship between HEIs and the HEA that reflects our new mandate and respects institutional autonomy. Key achievements in 2013 were:

- Strategic dialogue and performance funding based on the outcomes of the strategic dialogue process are the key tools to ensure system governance. As already set out, the strategic dialogue process is well underway and the system's compliance with national objectives will be an essential element of the future governance of higher education.
- A priority for the HEA throughout 2013 was the on-going monitoring of governance returns from HEIs in line with the code of governance requirements.
- Intense engagement has taken place with WIT to ensure delivery of the recommendations of the Report of the Inspector appointed by the Minister.



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Strategic Objective 5


Excellence in Higher Education

Outcomes concerned with excellence in higher education are required in three main areas – Teaching and Learning, Research and Innovation and Engagement. Excellence in each area must be a priority outcome so that the student experience can be maximised within a higher education system that provides quality teaching underpinned by a strong and vibrant quality research system and that is closely connected to national and international social and economic development. Key achievements in 2013 were:

- The establishment of the National Forum for the Enhancement of Teaching and Learning on a fully operational basis.
- The National Forum is the key system-level infrastructure for the enhancement of teaching and learning in higher education.
- The completion of the pilot national student survey and the launch of the Irish Survey of Student Engagement (ISSE) as an annual national student survey, the first of its kind in Europe. The findings will assist HEIs to enhance the quality of education they provide by asking students in detail about their experiences.
- The transition from secondary to higher education will be enhanced through the broadening of entry-routes to NFQ level 8 undergraduate programmes, as well as through the reform of the Leaving Certificate examination. This reform is being led by a consortium of agencies, including the HEA, and it has been greatly advanced in 2013. The Supporting a Better Transition from Second Level to Higher Education: Key Directions and Next Steps report was published in March, detailing the work that is to be undertaken; and a national conference was hosted in June to provide an opportunity for consultation on the report's recommendations with the higher education community.
- The publication of the results of the employers survey which provide a clear sense of employers' perspectives on HEIs and the identification of areas for further improvement. This valuable input to policy making and institutional decision making processes will be updated in 2014 with a new employers survey.



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

- The framework for PhD education was developed during 2013 and is in the process of implementation across all universities and institutes of technology.
- The LIRE research equipment database was completed and a National Guidelines on Access to Research Infrastructure approved.
- The roll-out of a new Postgraduate Programme in Professional Practice (PGPP), which will be delivered by HEIs in partnership with industry, is providing an opportunity for graduates to acquire cross-disciplinary skills in a work-based environment, facilitating the transition from higher education to employment. Postgraduate students enrolling on the PGPP will undertake an accredited internship in a company as part of their course, supporting work-based learning while also strengthening the links between the higher education and enterprise sectors.
- In response to the deficit in high-level ICT skills in Ireland, the HEA has made great progress in the implementation of the joint government–industry ICT Action Plan (January 2012). The higher education system has increased the output of ICT graduates by 25% over the last two years, and a doubling of graduate output in ICT (a key target of the Action Plan) is now expected to be achieved by 2015—ahead of the target delivery-date of 2018.
- The Campus Engage Network for the Promotion of Civic Engagement in Irish Higher Education, funded through the HEA's Strategic Innovation Fund, has been broadened into a national network, now coordinated from within the IUA. The Campus Engage Network promotes civic engagement in higher education—through teaching, practice-based learning, and community-based research—and is developing a national online portal for student volunteering opportunities.

Strategic Objective 6

Strategic Programmes

Equity of Access and Lifelong Learning

A priority outcome for the HEA is a higher education system that is characterised by equality of opportunity, with clear access, transfer and progression pathways and flexibility in modes of learning well mainstreamed into the higher education system. Key achievements in 2013 were:

- The publication of an in-depth policy paper on part-time education in higher education. The recommendations are now in the process of implementation.
- The roll-out of Springboard 2013 which offers 204 courses in 38 HEIs and on-going monitoring and evaluation of Springboard outputs and outcomes. While final figures are not yet available, the enrolment figure for Springboard 2013 will be over 5,000 students. Evaluation of outcomes to-date indicate that within six months, on average 40% of graduates are back in employment and almost 40% are engaged in further study.
- The roll-out of the 2013 ICT Skills Programme, through which 15 programmes are being provided across 14 HEIs, facilitating the up-skilling of graduates with degrees in cognate disciplines in a growth-area within the Irish economy. Of the 801 participants who enrolled on the 2011/12 ICT Skills Programme, 63.7% completed the course, and 50% of these students were in employment 6 months after completion.
- A national conference was hosted by the HEA's National Access Office in November 2013 as part of the consultation process in the development of a new national access plan.

PART 2

Other significant
developments in 2013

Funding

The difficult economic situation continued to predominate the higher education sector as regards funding in 2013 with a further reduction in core recurrent allocations. The original allocation to the HEA for 2013 was €1,036,100,000. This represented a reduction of €82.7m (c.7%) on the 2012 outturn of €1,118,804,000. Included in this figure was a once off reduction of €25m which was intended to impact on cash balances in the HEIs. This was applied to the fee grants for the sector. The student contribution increased by €250 in 2013 to €2,500. Once the €25m was excluded from the above overall reduction and the full year impact of the increase in the student contribution was taken into account, the overall decrease in funding to the higher education sector was of the order of 2%.

In July 2013, the HEA was notified of a further reduction to the 2013 Recurrent Grant – a reduction of €19,645,000 relating to pay savings arising from the Haddington Road Agreement and the Financial Measures in the Public Interest Act 2013. This was applied equally to both the University and Institute of Technology sectors. The final outturn for 2013 was €1,011,987,000.

Notwithstanding the difficult recurrent position, the HEA required that all institutions achieve a breakeven outturn for 2013. Annual budget meetings were held with all of the higher education institutions in March and April 2013.

Throughout 2013, the HEA worked closely with a number of institutions who experienced financial difficulty.

Table 1 provides detail on the final outturn of the 2013 Recurrent Grant to Universities, Institutes of Technology and Other Colleges.

Employment Control Framework (ECF)

Institutions were informed in June 2013 that further reductions in public sector numbers would be required by 31st December 2013. The overall sectoral reduction required was 2.5%. Overall, staff numbers in the sector have been reduced in line with the target set. Since the commencement of the ECF in December 2008, core staff numbers across the sector have been reduced by 12.1%.

Development of the Funding model

Responses to the HEA consultation document on reform of the funding models were considered and priorities identified for the universities and the institutes of technology.

Changes to the model were agreed in respect of the following;

- Removing the existing financial disincentive in the IOT sector to expand and develop Level 6 and 7 programmes, due to their lower fee levels;
- Inclusion of Distance Education numbers (Level 8 and above) in the University funding model.

These changes were implemented in the context of the 2014 grant allocation to the HEIs in December 2013. Further work on the development of the model will be undertaken in 2014.

Code of Governance

The revised Code of Governance of the Institutes of Technology was approved in the Institutes of Technology. Annual Governance statements from all HEIs were reviewed by the HEA.

Review Group on Apprenticeship

The HEA interacted with the Review Group on Apprenticeship, which submitted their report to the Minister for Education and Skills in December.

Review of Expenses

A report on Governing Body expenses in the IoT sector was completed and submitted to the Department of Education and Skills.

Students Assistance Fund

The Department of Education and Skills agreed that interest accumulated in the HEA bank accounts could be allocated to the Students Assistance Fund in December 2013. The additional funding was allocated in the same way as the core SAF allocation for 2013-14 (i.e. based on full-time enrolment data and data in respect of the Equal Access Initiative). Each institution received their additional allocation in January 2014.


Internationalisation

- The HEA was re-appointed by the DES as the National Agency for the new Erasmus+ Programme for the next seven years.
- As the National Agency for Erasmus, the HEA set the target of delivering 3,000 learning mobilities by the end of 2013/14 and is on target to achieve this as the provisional figure for 2012/23 is 2,971.
- Under the Brazilian Science Without Borders Programme, Ireland admitted 1,183 undergraduates in 2013 with each student spending up to a maximum of 18 months in Ireland. Twenty-three HEIs are involved in the undergraduate offer and the RCSI have also enrolled a number of PhD students. The early experiences and responses from the Brazilian students are very positive. For 2014, 2,160 students have applied to come to Ireland which represents an increase of circa 35% on the 2013 applications.
- Twenty-two scholarships were awarded for the 2013/14 academic year under the Government of Ireland Scholarships programme.

MSc in Audiology

The HEA issued a call for proposals for a two year full-time MSc in Audiology. Following an independent assessment process, it was recommended that the MSc in Audiology be located in University College Cork, with an intake of 10 students. The course will commence in September 2015.

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Support



Review of expenditure on Student Services

In November 2013, the HEA initiated a review of expenditure on student services. The review will examine the level of student involvement in the consultation process in relation to the disbursement of monies and will also review the specific expenditure on student services in higher education institutions.

Shared Services/Joint Procurement

The HEA during 2013 continued to work with the DES and the sector in the development of shared services and joint procurement initiatives.

Statutory Inspection at Waterford Institute of Technology (WIT)

In November 2012 the Minister for Education and Skills appointed Mr Dermot Quigley, former Chairperson of the Revenue Commissioners to carry out a review of the relationship between WIT and the companies providing services to it. The report was published in July 2013 and found that the relationship between WIT and the companies is unique in the Institute of Technology sector. The report noted that while the arrangements were well motivated and assisted with the development of the Institute, the relationship was not considered appropriate and should be regularised immediately. The report concludes that there was no evidence, or suggestions, of any misappropriations of funds and did not in any way relate to the academic reputation of the institute. Implementation of the report commenced immediately after its completion and is ongoing.

Review of Academic Workload Management

Irish higher education institutions have in recent years put in place workload allocation models that support increased transparency and productivity across the higher education sector. The HEA during 2013 commissioned a review of the core elements of these models and how higher education institutions manage the allocation of an academic's workload to ensure maximum effectiveness. As part of this review, the HEA hosted a seminar on Academic Workload, Priorities and Resource Management in Higher Education Institutions in November 2013. The review is due to be completed early in 2014.

Capital Programmes

2013 was another challenging year for Capital Funding. The annual capital budget for investment in higher education infrastructure was significantly lower than previous years at just over €68.90 million excluding PRTLI expenditure of €20.15 million.

2013 saw the completion of numerous capital projects within the Higher Education Sector. Some of the major capital projects completed and officially opened during 2013 were the UCD undergraduate Science Centre development, the extension to the John Paul II library at NUIM and the UCD Law School.

(a) UCD O'Brien Centre for Science

The redevelopment of the UCD Science Centre is Ireland's single largest capital development in the history of third-level education and has a total capital cost in excess of €250 million. 2013 saw the official opening of phase 2 of the UCD O'Brien Centre for Science at University College Dublin by the Minister for Education and Skills, Ruairí Quinn TD. The Centre now boasts in excess of 38,000m² of new and refurbished accommodation at an overall cost of almost €175 million. The Centre is now home to over 2,000 undergraduate students, more than 500 graduate students, and many more researchers across a range of scientific disciplines. The construction of phase 2 provided more than 1,000 jobs over three years.

Phase 3 of the UCD O'Brien Centre for Science, which will complete the suite of facilities for the sciences at University College Dublin, is currently in the planning stage.

(b) St. Patricks College Drumcondra Campus Development Project

2013 saw the re-commencement of the St. Patricks College Drumcondra Campus Development Project. The €50 million project was at a standstill for almost two years following the appointment of a receiver to the developer. The provision of new teaching accommodation and refurbishment of the existing buildings is necessary to address space deficiencies and to adequately support the academic programme delivery to a student population of up to 2,500, in a campus originally designed to accommodate 800 students. The development is central to the College's Campus Development Plan.

(c) The Programme for Research in Third Level Institutes - PRTLI

The HEA during 2013 also managed the implementation of the capital elements of several PRTLI cycle 5 research projects on behalf of the Department of Jobs, Enterprise and Innovation. Key PRTLI research capital projects funded in 2013 include: the new TCD Biomedical Sciences Institute, the research bundle at NUIG which includes a new Arts Social Science and Humanities Research Building and a new Biomedical Sciences building as well as a translational research element at Galway University Hospital, new space for biosciences research at UCC and research elements of the UCD Science Centre development.


(d) Institutes of Technology – Property Purchases

In 2013, the HEA approved the purchase of property at the Institutes of Technology, Tallaght, Dundalk and Limerick.

(e) DIT Grangegorman

2013 signalled a significant escalation in the physical development of the DIT Grangegorman Campus project. Construction commenced on a €26 million 'Site Infrastructure and Public Realm' contract. The €26 million contract will provide the underpinning infrastructure and services that will enable the build out of the new development. The project will be transformative for Dublin's inner city in terms of higher education, health, community and enterprise. The Grangegorman project, which has the support of the European Investment Bank, is the biggest development of its kind in any European capital city. In addition to the 'Site Infrastructure and Public Realm' contract, three further contracts were agreed in 2013. These will be carried out by Irish contractors.

In July 2012 as part of the Government's jobs Stimulus Plan, Minister for Public Expenditure and Reform Mr. Brendan Howlin T.D announced that a Grangegorman PPP project, worth €200 million would go ahead as a flagship project. That project went out to tender on 31st October 2013 and the two quadrangles which are being built through this process are due to be occupied by 10,000 DIT students in September 2017. The two quadrangles are due for completion at the same time as the Luas Cross City, which will provide a new sustainable public transport service for the city and for the students and staff coming to the new campus in Grangegorman.

Travel and subsistence payments are in accordance with rates approved by the Minister for Public Expenditure and Reform. Details are outlined in the HEA accounts (note 19).

Labour Relations Commission Proposals for the Public Service 2013-16 (Haddington Road Agreement)

The HEA implemented the terms of the above agreement which came into effect from 1st July 2013.

The HEA is subject to the Government's employment control framework. The ECF target for the HEA and Irish Research Council as at 31/12/13 was 58. The actual number of staff employed by the HEA (including the Council) at that date was 53.6, this excludes a small number of staff employed on EU funded fixed term contracts which are excluded from the HEA/Council ECF targets.

Functions and Legislation

The general functions of the HEA derive from the following legislation:

1971 Higher Education Authority Act,

1997 Universities Act

2006 Institute of Technology Act

National Strategy for Higher Education published in 2011

These functions include:

Development: (a) Furthering the development of higher education

Co-ordination: (b) Assisting in the co-ordination of the state investments in Higher education and preparing proposals for such investment

Promotion: (c) Promoting an appreciation of the value of higher education and research

Equity: (d) Promoting the equality of opportunity in higher education

Democracy: (e) Promoting the democratization of the structure of higher education

Excellence: (d) Promoting the attainment and maintenance of excellence on learning, teaching and research in higher education (from 2006 Act)

Further functions from the 1971 Act include:

- Advising the Minister on the need for the establishment of new institutions.
- Maintain a continuous review of the demand and need for higher education.
- Conduct and publish studies on challenges affecting higher education and research
- Assess amount of state financial provision, both current and capital, which recommends for higher education and research.
- Allocate among Universities, Institutes of Technology and the designated institutions the grants voted by the Oireachtas.

Under the **1997 Universities Act**, and the subsequent **Institutes of Technology Act 2006** the Higher Education Authority's remit broadened and it now carries out an additional number of functions in respect of the higher education sector.

Areas covered include review of:

- Strategic development plans
- Quality Assurance procedures
- Equality and access policies & implementation
- Frameworks for: Salary Departures; Borrowing; payments to staff by Institutional Corporations; Acquisition of Land.

National Strategy for Higher Education

The National Strategy for Higher Education assigns certain operational responsibilities to the HEA including establishing high level key performance indicators for the sector and engaging in strategic dialogue with individual institutions and leading and driving the process of structural change. The HEA provided the Minister for Education and Skills advice on a system configuration and inter-institutional collaboration in April. The Minister in May provided the green light for a major programme of structural reform which also provides for a new relationship between the state and HEIs. In July 2013 the Minister published a performance framework for the system.

Other relevant Legislation

There are a number of Government Acts which have particular relevance to the HEA in the management of its business

Freedom of Information Act

- Since January 2001, the HEA is covered by the provisions of the Freedom of information (FOI) Act, 1997. The Act asserts the right of members of the public to obtain access to official information to the greatest extent possible, consistent with the public interest and the right to privacy of individuals. This Act established three new statutory rights:
 - A legal right for each person to access information held by public bodies;
 - A legal right for each person to have official information relating to him/herself amended where it is incomplete, incorrect or misleading;
 - A legal right to obtain decisions affecting oneself.

To date, the HEA has received 97 requests (October 2001-December 2013).

The FOI Act allows public access to records held by the HEA, which are not routinely available through other sources. Access to information under the Act is subject to certain exemptions and involves specific procedures and time limits.

Copies of the HEA Manuals-Section 15 (Structure and Functions of the Authority) and Section 16 (outlines the rules, regulations and precedents used by the HEA in carrying out its functions) as required under the Act, are available on the HEA website: <http://www.hea.ie/en/freedom-of-information>

The HEA received seven requests under the Act during 2013. Three of these were granted, two were partially granted, one was refused and one request withdrawn.

Official Languages Act, 2003

The HEA is designated under the Official Languages Act, 2003. The primary objective of the act is to ensure better availability and a higher standard of public services through Irish. The Official Languages Act seeks to give legislative effect, insofar as the delivery of public services is concerned, to Article 8 of the Constitution as follows:

- The Irish language as the national language is the first official language
- The English language is recognized as a second official language
- Provision may, however, be made by law for the exclusive use of either of the said languages for one or more official purposes, either throughout the State or any part thereof

In accordance with Part 3, (section 9-13) of the Act, the HEA prepared a scheme specifying which services it proposes to provide through the following channels:

- Exclusively through the medium of the Irish language
- Exclusively through the medium of the English language, and
- Through the medium of both the Irish and English languages.

Re-Use of Public Sector Information

The re-use of Public Sector information regulations 2005 sets out a harmonized framework within which public sector data from across the EU can be accessed. The Directive is intended to stimulate economic activity, innovation and competition and to assist the evolution of an information and knowledge-based, economy and society

The Higher Education Authority complies with the regulations on the re-use of Public Sector information regulations 2005 and actively encourages the re-use of the information that we produce. The regulations are available at www.psi.gov.ie

Ethics in Public Office Act, 1995 and Standards in Public Office Act, 2001

In accordance with the provisions of the above Acts, members of the Authority are obliged to provide any statements of interest each year to the Standards in Public office Commission. Senior members of the Executive also provide statements of interest to the Chief Executive.

Employment Equality Acts, 1998 and 2004

The HEA is committed to a policy of equal opportunities. The HEA has agreed with its staff a number of policies including an equal opportunities policy and dignity at work policy. The Authority also has in place a number of schemes to enhance work-life balance opportunities including a flexi time scheme and a formal policy on part-time working agreed in 2008. The HEA makes voluntary annual returns to the Department of Education and Science under the 2005 Disability Act.

Safety, Health and Welfare Act, 1989

The HEA has prepared a safety statement in accordance with the Act. This was reviewed in 2007. In 2007 the HEA introduced an Employee Assistant programme for its staff and pensioners. The HEA Executive has a health and safety committee who met twice in 2013.

Prompt Payment of Accounts Act, 1997

The HEA complies with the provision of the above Act and has put in a place procedures to ensure all invoices are paid promptly. Interest payments of €x were paid during 2013 in respect of 38 invoices.

Quality Customer Service Plan

Following consultation with its stakeholders the Authority adopted a Quality Customers Service Plan in 2005. This plan is to be updated in 2014 having regard to the HEA's revised role under the National Strategy for Higher Education and the amalgamation of the two Research Councils in 2012.

Environment Friendly Initiatives

The HEA operates a recycling scheme. The Authority took further measures to cut back on the use of paper. The HEA also recycles print toner.

Report for presentation to the Houses of the Oireachtas

An tÚdarás um Ard-Oicheachas

I have audited the financial statements of An tÚdarás um Ard-Oicheachas for the year ended 31 December 2013 under the Higher Education Authority Act 1971. The financial statements, which have been prepared under the accounting policies set out therein, comprise the statement of accounting policies, the income and expenditure account, the statement of total recognised gains and losses, the balance sheet, the cash flow statement and the related notes and schedules. The financial reporting framework that has been applied in their preparation is the Higher Education Authority Act 1971 and generally accepted accounting practice in Ireland.

Responsibilities of An tÚdarás

An tÚdarás is responsible for the preparation of the financial statements, for ensuring that they give a true and fair view of the state of the affairs of An tÚdarás and of its income and expenditure, and for ensuring the regularity of transactions.

Responsibilities of the Comptroller and Auditor General

My responsibility is to audit the financial statements and report on them in accordance with the Higher Education Authority Act 1971.

My audit is carried out in accordance with the International Standards on Auditing (UK and Ireland) and in compliance with the Auditing Practices Board's Ethical Standards for Auditors.

Scope of audit of the financial statements

An audit involves obtaining evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements, sufficient to give reasonable assurance that the financial statements are free from material misstatement, whether caused by fraud or error. This includes an assessment of

- whether the accounting policies are appropriate to the circumstances of An tÚdarás, and have been consistently applied and adequately disclosed
- the reasonableness of significant accounting estimates made in the preparation of the financial statements, and
- the overall presentation of the financial statements.

I also seek to obtain evidence about the regularity of financial transactions in the course of audit.

Opinion on the financial statements

In my opinion, the financial statements, which have been properly prepared in accordance with generally accepted accounting practice in Ireland, give a true and fair view of the state of affairs of An tÚdarás 1t 31 December 2013.

In my opinion, prpoer books of account have been kept by In my opinion,. The financial statements are in agreement with the books of account.

Matters on which I report by exception

I report by exception if

- I have not received all the information and explanations I required for my audit, or
- my audit noted any material instance where public money has not been applied for the purposes intended or where the transactions did not conform to the authorities governing them, or
- the statement on internal financial control does not reflect the compliance of An tÚdarás with the Code of Practice for the Governance of State Bodies, or
- I find there are other material matters relating to the manner in which public business has been conducted.

Pension funding

Historically, universities that operated funded pension schemes received recurrent grant funding from An tÚdarás to cover salary costs plus employer pension contributions. Following the introduction of the model pension schemes for new employees, which do not involve employer contributions, An tÚdarás did not adjust downwards the funding provided to the universities. Instead, it instructed the universities to set aside in separate funds the employee pension contributions paid by model scheme members, together with amounts equivalent to employer contributions. The accumulated funds in the five universities concerned stood at €125 million at 30 September 2013 (30 September 2012: €94 million).

I have nothing to report in regard to other matters.

Statement of the System of Internal Financial Controls.

1. On behalf of the members of the Higher Education Authority I acknowledge our responsibility for ensuring that an effective system of internal financial controls is maintained and operated.
2. The system of internal financial controls can provide only reasonable and not absolute assurance that assets are safeguarded, transactions are authorised and properly recorded, and that material errors or irregularities are either prevented or would be detected in a timely period.

3. Key Control Procedures

The Authority has taken steps to ensure an appropriate control environment by:

- Clearly defining management responsibilities, including segregation of duties;
- Adopting the principles of corporate governance contained in the Code of Practice for Governance of State bodies;
- Establishing formal procedures for reporting significant control failures and ensuring appropriate corrective action is taken; and
- Establishing formal procedures to monitor the activities and safeguard the assets of the organisation.

The system of internal financial controls is based on a framework of regular management information, a system of delegation and accountability, a set of financial and administrative procedures and rigorous ongoing checks by the finance function. In particular it includes:

- A comprehensive budgeting system with an annual budget, which is reviewed and approved by the members of the Authority;
- Regular review by the members of the Authority of periodic and annual financial information and reports which indicate financial performance against budgets; and
- Setting authorisation limits for expenditure in relation to requisition of funds and disbursement of funds.

The Authority has an Audit Committee who meet on a regular basis to review the work of Internal Audit. The Audit Committee report to the Authority. The work of the Internal Audit is outsourced and Internal Audit plans are based on a risk analysis profile. The Audit Committee agreed in March 2013 a medium term work-plan. The plan includes provision for a review of internal financial controls on an annual basis. A new plan will be approved by the Committee once internal auditors have been appointed following a supplementary tender undertaken jointly by the HEA and State Examinations Commission in September 2014.

An tÚdarás um Ard-Oideachas **Statement of the System of Internal Financial Controls.**

The Authority's monitoring and review of the effectiveness of the system of internal financial control is informed by the work of the internal auditor, the Audit Committee, the executive management team of the Authority which has responsibility for the development and maintenance of the financial controls framework, and comments made by the Comptroller and Auditor General in his report as applicable.

The HEA's outsourced internal auditors carried out a review of internal financial controls in July 2013 and August 2014. The latter report was considered by the Audit Committee at its meeting held 9th September 2014. During 2013 the Committee considered two further internal audit reports, follow up on prior Internal Audit Reports at its meeting held 10th September and a review on Procurement at its meeting held 12th November 2013. The Committee approved an updated procurement policy at that meeting.

The Authority has approved a risk management framework and with the assistance of the internal auditors a risk register has been put in place. The Audit Committee received a report from the CEO on implementation of the HEA's risk management framework at its meeting in July 2014.

Statement of Accounting Policies

An tÚdarás um Ard-Oideachas was established on 15 May 1972 to perform functions assigned to it by Acht an Údarás um Ard-Oideachas 1971. The format of its financial statements has been approved by the Minister for Education and Skills with the concurrence of the Minister for Finance and comprise Income and Expenditure Account, Statement of Total Recognised Gains and Losses, Balance Sheet and a Cash Flow Statement.

ACCOUNTING POLICIES

1. Basis of Accounting

The Financial Statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention. These Statements are prepared on an accruals basis, except as stated below, and are in accordance with generally accepted accounting practice. Financial Reporting Standards, recommended by the Accounting Standards Board, are adopted as they become effective.

2. Oireachtas Grants

Income from Oireachtas grants represents accrued income in the year.

3. Fixed Assets

The fixed assets of the Authority comprising furniture and equipment and computers are stated in the financial statements at cost or valuation less accumulated depreciation and provision for impairment where applicable.

Depreciation and Provision for Impairment

Computers are depreciated at a rate of 33 1/3 % per annum straight line method. All other fixed assets are depreciated at a rate of 10% per annum straight line method. Where evidence of impairment exists the Authority compares the carrying value of the affected assets with the higher of value in use and expected disposal proceeds less cost to sell. Value in use is measured as discounted cash-flows expected to flow from similar assets grouped as cash generating units.

4. Capital Funding

The assets of the Authority are financed out of administration grants. The Capital Reserve Account represents the amount of income allocated for capital purposes less the amount released to revenue over the life of the assets.

5. Grants allocated to Universities, Institutes of Technology and Designated Institutions;

The expenditure under these headings represents the grants which were allocated to the Universities and the Institutes of Technology in respect of the year. The designated institutions are St. Patrick's College Drumcondra, Mary Immaculate College, St. Angela's College and Mater Dei. These grants are applied by the institutions on the following basis:

(a) Recurrent Grants

In addition to meeting running expenses these grants may also be applied for certain other purposes, including the purchase of furniture, the replacement of equipment or the carrying out of minor capital projects.

(b) Building Grants

These grants are used to meet building, infrastructure, property acquisitions and refurbishment costs, and in certain circumstances may be used to fund initial issues of library stock, equipment or furniture.

(c) Research Initiative Grants

These grants comprise

- Funding under the Programme for Research in Third Level Institutions (PRTLI) for recurrent and capital purpose schemes.
- Funding under the Research Schemes of the Irish Research Council for Humanities and Social Science (IRCHSS) and the Irish Research Council for Science, Engineering and Technology (IRCSET), now Irish Research Council (IRC).
- Funding since 1 October 1999 on behalf of the Department of Education and Skills under a post doctoral fellowship scheme.

(d) The National Office for Equality of Access to Higher Education.

These grants comprise

- Funding under the Student Assistance Programme.
- Funding under the fund for Students with Disabilities.

An tÚdarás um Ard-Oideachas **Statement of Accounting Policies**

SUPERANNUATION

The Higher Education Authority operates a defined benefit pension scheme approved under Section 15 of the Acht an Údaráis um Ard-Oideachas, 1971 which is funded annually on a pay as you go basis from monies provided by the Department of Education and Skills and from contributions deducted from staff salaries.

Pension costs reflect pension benefits earned by employees in the period and are shown net of staff pension contributions which are retained by the Higher Education Authority. An amount corresponding to the pension charge is recognised as income to the extent that it is recoverable, and offset by grants received in the year to discharge pension payments.

Actuarial gains or losses arising on scheme liabilities are reflected in the Statement of Total Recognised Gains and Losses and a corresponding adjustment is recognised in the amount recoverable from the Department of Education and Skills.

Pension liabilities represent the present value of future pension payments earned by staff to date. Deferred pension funding represents the corresponding asset to be recovered in future periods from the Department of Education and Skills.




Other funding included €2.1 million (2012: €2.4 million) received from the Department of Community, Equality and Gaeltacht Affairs.

Research Income of €86.8 million (2012: €91.2 million) includes Capital and Recurrent grants.

12. LIFELONG LEARNING PROGRAMME - EU

The HEA is the national agency in Ireland for the EU funded Life Long Learning programme.

ERASMUS GRANTS SCHEME

This scheme provides grants for transnational student mobility within the member states of the EU, covering a period between three and twelve months. To be eligible a person must be a fully registered student pursuing a full time course in an approved third level institution.

Funding is received from the EU and paid out to the Universities and Colleges on an academic year basis. Allocations to Universities and Colleges for the 2013/2014 and 2012/2013 academic years were €6.3 million and €6.3 million respectively.

Unexpended amounts are refundable to the EU at the end of each academic year.

13. CAPITAL COMMITMENTS

The amount of capital commitments under contract and approved by the Authority at 31 December 2013 amounted to €134.5 million (2012: €194.1 million). Commitments not under contract but approved by the Authority are estimated at €6.1 million at 31 December 2013 (2012: €5.9 million).

14. LEASE OF ACCOMMODATION

Premises at Brooklawn House, Shelbourne Road, Ballsbridge, Dublin 4 are held under two separate tenancy agreements.

The first floor is held under a 25 year agreement from May 2001 with a 5 year review at an annual cost of €0.521 million.

The ground floor is held under a 25 year agreement from November 2001 with a 5 year review at an annual cost of €0.320 million. There was no change in the rent for both floors of Brooklawn House following a rent review in 2011.

15. Comparative Figures

Comparative figures have been adjusted to conform with changes in presentation in these financial statements.

16. Related Parties

HEAnet Ltd. was incorporated on 12 November, 1997. The company is limited by Guarantee with no Share Capital and the Higher Education Authority is an Ordinary member of the company. Other Ordinary members of the company are TCD, UCC, UCD, NUIG, UL, DCU, NUIM, DIT, Athlone IT, Carlow IT and DJEI. Income for 2013 was €18.5 million (2012: €17.7 million). There was a deficit in 2013 of €83,570 (2012: €25,033). The company provides internet services to subscriber higher educational and research Institutions, Houses of the Oireachtas as well as primary and post primary schools and other research organisations. There was an accumulated surplus of €574,247 on the company's activities as at 31 December 2013, (€657,817 at 31 December 2012). The HEA paid total grants to HEAnet Ltd of €9 million in 2013, (€8.3 million in 2012).

Member's fees and travel and subsistence expenses are paid in accordance with rates set by the Department of Public Expenditure and Reform. The approved annual fee for members of the HEA is as follows; Chairperson €11,970, Ordinary Member €7,695. Under the 'One Person, One Salary' Principle, implemented from 1st November 2011 the fee is not paid to a member in receipt of a public sector salary. Members who finished or started in July were paid a pro-rata fee. Expenses may include directly reimbursable claims or expenses paid on behalf of the Member.

Chief Executive's remuneration and expenses.

The Chief Executive Remuneration for 2013 was €142,914. Expenses (€15,951) include the following categories: motor travel, subsistence, accommodation, flights, taxis, transport and sundry items. Chief Executive of the HEA was seconded from the Department of Education and Skills until 4 January 2013 and became a member of the HEA superannuation scheme from this date. The salary for the Chief Executive and all staff in the HEA is approved by the Minister for Education and Skills and the Minister for Public Expenditure and Reform. The Chief Executive Salary reduced from €145,952 to €136,276 from 1st July 2013 following implementation of the Labour Relations Commission Proposals (May 2013) for Public Service Stability Agreement 2013-2016 'Haddington Road Agreement'

Chairman remuneration and expenses.

The Chairman's Fee for 2013 was €11,970. Expenses (€3,300) include the following categories: motor travel, flights, subsistence, taxis, and sundry items. The Chairman is not a member of the HEA superannuation scheme. The Chairman was appointed on 25 January 2011.

hearráidí ábhartha nó mírialtachtaí, nó go n-aimseofaí go tráthúil iad, tá iarracht déanta ag an Údarás céimeanna a chur i bhfeidhm lena chinntíú go bhfeidhmíonn timpeallacht iomchuí rialaithe san ÚAO. Tá mionsonraí orthu seo sa ráiteas ar an gcóras do rialú inmheánach airgeadais, ar chuid de na cuntais iniúchta é. Rinne iniúchóirí inmheánacha an ÚAO athbhreithniú ar rialuithe inmheánacha an ÚAO i mí lúil 2013. Déanfar athbhreithniú eile níos déanaí i mbliana.

- Tá an ÚAO tar éis glacadh le cód iompraíochta gnó do Bhaill an Údarás agus dá fhostaithe. Déanadh athbhreithniú agus nuashonrú ar an gcód do Bhaill i mí Márta 2010. Rinne an tÚdarás measúnú ar a fheidhmíocht i 2009 agus críochnaíodh athbhreithniú eile ar rialachas i nDeireadh Fómhair 2012. Rinne baill athbhreithniú measúnaithe éifeachtúlachta i mí Eanáir 2014.
- Déanann an ÚAO de réir treoirlínte an rialtais maidir le luach saothair. Tá táillí na mball de réir na rátaí atá ceadaithe ag an Roinn faoi mar atá na tuarastail agus na liúntais a íocatar leis an bhfoireann. Cuireann an ÚAO an ciorclán Duine Amháin, Tuarastal Amháin a d'eisigh an Roinn Caiteachais Phoiblí agus Athchóirithe, i bhfeidhm.
- Níl aon imeacht iar-chláir chomhardaithe le tuairisciú ag an ÚAO.
- Tá beartas um sholáthar ag an ÚAO a thagann le treoirlínte An Roinn Caiteachais Phoiblí agus Athchóirithe. Aontaíonn an ÚAO le roinnt creat-chomhaontú de chuid na Seirbhise Náisiúnta Soláthair.
- Tá polasaí taistil ag an ÚAO a thagann le treoirlínte An Roinn Caiteachais Phoiblí agus Athchóirithe.
- Níl aon mholtaí maidir le caiteachas caipítíl ag an ÚAO faoi láthair.

Bheadh áthas ar an ÚAO aon soiléiriú breise a bheadh ag teastáil uait maidir le haon ní thusa a sholáthar.

Ba mhaith liom buíochas a ghabháil leat féin agus led oifigigh sa Roinn as an gcúnamh a tugadh le faomhadh a fháil ar phostanna breise don Fheidhmeannas. Tuigim go hiomlán cé chomh neamhghnách atá a leithéid de chinneadh sna cúinsí reatha. Ba mhaith liom freisin buíochas a ghabháil leis an mbeirt bhall a d'fhág an tÚdarás i rith 2013, Kathleen Lough agus John Logue.

Táim féin, in éineacht leis an Údarás agus a fheidhmeannas, ag tnúth le leanúint ag obair leat féin agus le do Roinn, go háirithe ar fhorfheidhmiú chinntí an Rialtais ón mbliain seo caite maidir le cumraíocht an ardoideachais agus frámaíocht an chórais fheidhmíochta.

Forbhreathnú ginearálta

Ba bhliain shuntasach í 2013 i stair an ardoideachais in Éirinn, le dul chun cinn soiléir á dhéanamh ar bhealaí éagsúla maidir le forfheidhmiú na moltaí a leagadh síos sa Straitéis Náisiúnta Ardoideachais. Bhain na príomh-mholtáí le córas níos comhordaithe a chruthú d'institiúidí ardoideachais le misean sonrach agus comhchaidreamh nua idir an earnáil agus an Rialtas, dírithe níos mó ar thorthaí ón earnáil, trí thagairt do chuspóirí sonraithe náisiúnta le maoiniú, sa todhchaí, nasctha le feidhmíocht. Tosaíodh ar an bpróiseas maidir leis na cuspóirí seo, comhphlé straitéiseach, le haighneachtaí óna hinstiúidí, athbhreithniú ag saineolaithe náisiúnta agus idirnáisiúnta agus cruinnithe le gach institiúid as ar tháinig comhaontú ar dhlúthú (a críochnaíodh i mí Eanáir 2014). Bhain ardleibhéal rannpháirtíochta na n-institiúidí leis an bpróiseas, a léirigh oscailteachta san earnáil d'athchóiriú forleathan agus feabhas ar fhreagracht. Thug an próiseas leibhéal nua freagrachta don ÚAO, le freagracht tuairisciú go bliantúil ar fheidhmíocht an chórais ardoideachais.

Leanadh go hiomlán leis an gclár athchóirithe le cúinsí airgeadais go hainnis san earnáil le ciorrú eile de c. 7% ar mhaoiniú athfhillteach agus tionchar leanúnach an chreat rialaithe fostáiochta ar leibhéal na foirne. D'ainneoin na ndúshlán seo bhain formhór na n-institiúidí fás amach maidir le líon na mac léinn agus lean siad ag cur le céimeanna gníomhachtaithe an mhargaidh fhostaíochta. Bhain siad cóimheá airgid amach freisin, ach ag deireadh na bliana ba léir go raibh strus ar fud na hearnála le líon beag institiúidí ag feidhmiú le heasnamh bunúsach.


- Chuir an ÚAO tuarascáil faoi bhráid an Aire Oideachais agus Scileanna ar athchuimríocht chórais, comhoibriú idirinstítíudeach agus rialachas chórais in Aibreán 2013. Sholáthair freagra an Aire i mBealtaine 2013 cead le dul ar aghaidh le mórchláir athchóirithe struchtúrach agus comhchaidreamh nua idir an Stát agus na IAOanna. Tosaíodh ar fhorfheidhmiú sa dara leath de 2013 agus leanfaidh seo mar bhunchloch le pleán oibre an UAÓ i gcaitheamh 2014.
- Bhí Idirphlé Straitéiseach mar chuid fhoirmeálta den gcorás ardoideachais i 2013. Tá seo tar éis sainordú nua a sholáthar don ÚAO trí fhócas níos géire a bheith i gceist maidir le feidhmíocht IAO agus freagracht a bheith ar IAO maidir le feidhmíocht.  - I ndiaidh don Athbhreithíú um Oideachas Múinteoirí a bheith foilsithe tá an ÚAO ag obair leis na IAOanna le cur chun cinn a dhéanamh ar fhorfheidhmiú agus déanadh an-dul chun cinn maidir le roinnt de na hionaid nua atá beartaithe a bhunú.
- Sholáthair an ÚAO comhairle do Shainghrúpa Athbhreithnithe Printíseachta an ROS agus déanadh ionchorprú ar mhórán de mholtáí an ÚAO i dtuarascáil deiridh an ghrúpa a bhfuil an tAire ag féachaint air.





- Eagrú chomhdháil idirnáisiúnta Uachtarántachta na hÉireann ar an AE, 'Rangú agus Infheictheacht Torthaí Ardchaighdeáin i Réimse Ardoideachais na hEorpa', a tionóladh i gCaisleán Bhaile Átha Cliath i mí Eanáir 2013. Ba é seo an príomhimeacht ardoideachais d'Uachtarántacht na hÉireann ar Chomhairle an Aontais Eorpaigh (2013), a sholáthair deis comhphlé i measc na bpáirtithe leasmhara ón Eoraip agus níos faide annón ar conas is féidir le measúnú feidhmíochta san ardoideachas tacú le misean agus tosaíochtaí straitéiseacha na hearnála a chur chun cinn.
- Foilsíodh an chéad tuarascáil measúnaithe feidhmíochta earnála d'ardoideachas na hÉireann, I dTreo Chreat Mheasúnaithe Fheidhmíochta: Próifíliú Ardoideachais na hÉireann. Ag tabhairt cuntais ar gach ÚAO atá maoinithe go poiblí, leagann an tuarascáil síoscreat tosaigh measúnaithe feidhmíochta don earnáil a thacóidh le hinstiúidí in mbainistíocht straitéiseach feidhmíochta, agus córas comhtháite ardoideachais a chur le chéile de réir na Straitéise Náisiúnta. Faoi mar atá leagtha síos cheana féin, tá an próiseas idirphlé straitéiseach faoi shiúl agus beidh comhlíonadh an chórais ar chuspóirí náisiúnta mar eilimint riachtanach de rialachas ardoideachais sa todhchaí.
- Bhí sé mar thosaíocht ag an ÚAO i rith 2013 monatóireacht leanúnach a dhéanamh ar thorthaí rialachais ó IAOanna ag teacht le riachtanais an chóid rialachais.
- Tharla dian-rannpháirtíocht le WIT le soláthar mholtáí Thuarascála an Chigire a cheap an tAire a chinntiú.



Is iad idirphlé straitéiseach agus maoiniú feidhmíochta bunaithe ar thorthaí an phróisis idirphlé straitéiseach na príomhuirlisí le rialachas córais a chinntiú.



Tá torthaí a bhaineann le sármhaitheas san ardoideachas ag teastáil i dtrí phríomhréimse – Múineadh agus Foghlaim, Taighde agus Nuálaíocht agus Rannpháirtíocht. Caithfidh sármhaitheas i ngach réimse a bheith mar thoradh tosaíochta i dtreo is gur féidir uasmhéadú a dhéanamh ar thaithí an mhic léinn sa chórás ardoideachais a sholáthraíonn múinteoiracht ar ardchraigheán le córas láidir agus beoga taighde ag tacú leis atá nasctha go dlúth le forbairt gheilleagrach agus sóisialta go náisiúnta agus go hidirnáisiúnta. Ba iad na príomhnithe a baineadh amach i 2013 ná:

- Bunú an Fhóram Náisiúnta um Theagasc agus Foghlaim a Fheabhsú ar bhonn oibríochtúil iomlán. Is é an Fóram Náisiúnta an príomhleibhéal-chórás bonneagair d'fheabhsú múinteoiracht agus foghlama san ardoideachas.
- Críochnú treoirshuirbhé náisiúnta mac léinn agus seoladh Suirbhé na hÉireann um Rannpháirtíocht Mac Léinn (SÉRML) mar shuirbhé náisiúnta bliantúil ar mhic léinn, an chéad cheann dá leithéid san Eoraip. Cabhróidh na torthaí le IAOanna feabhas a chur ar chaighdeán an oideachais a sholáthraíonn siad trí mhioncheisteanna a chur ar mhic léinn maidir lena dtaití.
- Cuirfear feabhas ar an aistriú ó mheánoideachas go hardoideachas trí na bealaí iontrála chuig cláir fhochéime CNC leibhéal 8, chomh maith le hathchóiriú ar scrúdú na hArdeistiméireachta. Tá an t-athchóiriú seo á threorú ag cuibhreannas de ghníomhairesreachtaí, ar a n-áirftear an ÚAO, agus cuireadh chun cinn go mór é i 2013. Foilsíodh an tuarascáil Tacú le hAistriú níos Fearr ón Dara Leibhéal go hArdoideachas: Príomh-threonna agus na Chéad Chéimeanna Eile sa Mhárta, ag sonrú na hoibre atá le déanamh; agus déanadh óstáil ar chomhdháil náisiúnta sa Mheitheamh le deis comhairliúcháin a sholáthar ar mholtáí an tuarascála leis an bpobal ardoideachais.
- Foilsíú thorthaí suirbhé na bhfostóirí a thugann léargas ar dhearcadh na bhfostóirí ar na IAOanna agus aithint réimsí ar féidir tuilleadh feabhas a chur orthu. Déanfar nuashonrú ar an ionchur luachmhar seo maidir le próisis cheaptha bheartais agus chinnteoireachta i 2014 le suirbhé nua fostóirí.



- Déanadhcreat d'oideachas PhD a fhorbairt i rith 2013 agus táthar i mbun é a chur i bhfeidhm i ngach ollscoil agus institiúid teicneolaíochta.
- Críochnaíodh bunachar sonraí trealamh taighde LIRE agus faomhadh Treoirínté Náisiúnta um Rochtain ar Bhonneagar Taighde.
- Tá feidhmiú céimneach Chláir nua larchéime i gCleachtas Gairmiúil (CICG), a sholáthróidh IAOanna i gcomhpháirtíocht le tionscail, ag soláthar deise d'iarchéimithe scileanna idirdhisciplíneacha a fháil i dtimpeallacht obairbhunaithe, ag éascú an trasdul ó ardoideachas chuig fostáiocht. Rachaidh mic léinn iarchéime a dhéanann rollú ar an CICG i mbun intéirneachta creidiúnaithe i gcuideachta mar chuid dá gcúrsa, ag tacú le foghlaim obairbhunaithe agus ag neartú na nasc idir na hearnálacha ardoideachais agus fiontraíochta.
- Mar fhreagra ar an easpa scileanna ardleibhéal TFC in Éirinn, tá an-dul chun cinn déanta ag an ÚAO maidir le forfheidhmiú Phlean Gníomhaíochta TFC an rialtais-tionsclaíochta (Eanáir 2012). Tá an córas ardoideachais tar éis aschur na gcéimithe TFC a mhéadú 25% le dhá bhliain anuas, agus táthar ag súil anois le méadú faoi dhó ar aschur chéimithe i TFC (príomhsprior den Phlean Gníomhaíochta) faoi 2015 – chun tosaigh ar an spriocdháta seachadta de 2018.

Cuireann an Gréasán Teaghála Campais comhpháirteachas poiblí chun cinn in ardoideachas – trí mhúineadh, foghlaim bunaithe ar chleachtadh, agus taighde pobalbhunaithe – agus tá tairseach náisiúnta ar líne á fhorbairt do dheiseanna oibre deonach ag mic léinn.

Cothromas Rochtana agus Foghlaim ar Feadh an tSaoil

Is é an toradh atá mar thosaíocht ag an ÚAO ná córas ardoideachais ina bhfuil comhionannas deise, le rochtain shoileir, bealaí le haistriú agus dul chun cinn a dhéanamh agus solúbhacht i modhanna foghlama i bpriomhshruithe an chórais ardoideachais. Ba iad na príomhnithe a baineadh amach i 2013 ná:

- Foilsíú mion-staidpháipéir ar oideachas páirtaimseartha san ardoideachas. Táthar anois i mbun na moltaí a fhorfheidhmiú.
- Feidhmiú céimneach Lingchlár 2013 a dhéanann 204 cursa a thairiscint i 38 IAO agus monatóireacht agus measúnú leanúnach ar thorthaí an Lingchláir. I mí na Samhna 2012 cheap an tAire Oideachais agus Scileanna Dermot Quigley, iar-Chathaoirleach na gCoimisinéirí loncaim le hathbhreithniú a dhéanamh ar an gcomhchaidreamh idir ITPL agus na cuideachtaí a sholáthraíonn seirbhísí di. 

In éineacht leis an gconradh ‘Bonneagar Láithreáin agus Limistéar Poiblí’, aontaíodh ar thrí chonradh eile i 2013. Beidh conraitheoirí Éireannacha ina mbun seo.

Report for presentation to the Houses of the Oireachtas

An tÚdarás um Ard-Oicheachas

I have audited the financial statements of An tÚdarás um Ard-Oicheachas for the year ended 31 December 2013 under the Higher Education Authority Act 1971. The financial statements, which have been prepared under the accounting policies set out therein, comprise the statement of accounting policies, the income and expenditure account, the statement of total recognised gains and losses, the balance sheet, the cash flow statement and the related notes and schedules. The financial reporting framework that has been applied in their preparation is the Higher Education Authority Act 1971 and generally accepted accounting practice in Ireland.

Responsibilities of An tÚdarás

An tÚdarás is responsible for the preparation of the financial statements, for ensuring that they give a true and fair view of the state of the affairs of An tÚdarás and of its income and expenditure, and for ensuring the regularity of transactions.

Responsibilities of the Comptroller and Auditor General

My responsibility is to audit the financial statements and report on them in accordance with the Higher Education Authority Act 1971.

My audit is carried out in accordance with the International Standards on Auditing (UK and Ireland) and in compliance with the Auditing Practices Board's Ethical Standards for Auditors.

Scope of audit of the financial statements

An audit involves obtaining evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements, sufficient to give reasonable assurance that the financial statements are free from material misstatement, whether caused by fraud or error. This includes an assessment of

- whether the accounting policies are appropriate to the circumstances of An tÚdarás, and have been consistently applied and adequately disclosed
- the reasonableness of significant accounting estimates made in the preparation of the financial statements, and
- the overall presentation of the financial statements.

I also seek to obtain evidence about the regularity of financial transactions in the course of audit.

Opinion on the financial statements

In my opinion, the financial statements, which have been properly prepared in accordance with generally accepted accounting practice in Ireland, give a true and fair view of the state of affairs of An tÚdarás at 31 December 2013.

In my opinion, proper books of account have been kept by An tÚdarás. The financial statements are in agreement with the books of account.

Matters on which I report by exception

I report by exception if

- I have not received all the information and explanations I required for my audit, or
- my audit noted any material instance where public money has not been applied for the purposes intended or where the transactions did not conform to the authorities governing them, or
- the statement on internal financial control does not reflect the compliance of An tÚdarás with the Code of Practice for the Governance of State Bodies, or
- I find there are other material matters relating to the manner in which public business has been conducted.

Pension funding

Historically, universities that operated funded pension schemes received recurrent grant funding from An tÚdarás to cover salary costs plus employer pension contributions. Following the introduction of the model pension schemes for new employees, which do not involve employer contributions, An tÚdarás did not adjust downwards the funding provided to the universities. Instead, it instructed the universities to set aside in separate funds the employee pension contributions paid by model scheme members, together with amounts equivalent to employer contributions. The accumulated funds in the five universities concerned stood at €125 million at 30 September 2013 (30 September 2012: €94 million).

I have nothing to report in regard to other matters.






