COMPLIANCE DEADLINE 18th APRIL 2019

"Member States shall ensure that contracting authorities and contracting entities receive and process electronic invoices which comply with the European standard on electronic invoicing"

European Directive 2014/55/EU





Invoice processing: Public Sector Context

In excess of 4 million invoices are processed by the Public Sector each year.

4

(Note: Data not available for all Public Sector Bodies)

It is estimated that 90% of all invoices are delivered by post and received as paper to the Public Sector.

Volume of invoices and turnaround payment times place high **administration burden** on

staff



Invoice volumes per annum:

- Health ~2m
- Local Gov ~1.2m
- Central Gov ~625k
- D/Ed(ETBs) ~300k



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elnvoicing - The Directive


European Directive 2014/55/EU

- 1. ALL Public Sector Bodies
- 2. NOT to contracts ... declared to be secret/accompanied by special security measures
- 3. Compliance by April 2019 (2020 for Local Government)
- 4. No requirement for Suppliers to submit elnvoices at this time
- 5. Member States are obliged to:
 - "... receive and process electronic invoices which comply with the European standard"






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PEPPOL – The eDelivery network for eProcurement








