elnvoicing – European Directive on elnvoicing (2014/55/EU)



"Member States shall ensure that contracting authorities and contracting entities receive and process electronic invoices which comply with the European standard on electronic invoicing" European Directive on elnvoicing in public procurement 2014/55/EU







elnvoicing - The European Directive 2014/55/EU

Key points to remember – a recap!

- ALL public bodies
- Applies to invoices relating to 'contracts' above EU thresholds
- Exemption: Contracts declared secret/accompanied by special security measures
- No requirement for Suppliers to submit elnvoices at this time
- Compliance by April 2019 (2020 for sub-central contracting authorities & entities)
- Directive is currently being transposed into Irish legislation
- Member States are obliged to:


"... receive and process electronic invoices which comply with the European standard"







elnvoicing – National Implementation Model




Next Steps: Preparation and Implementation

Decide how to obtain your elnvoicing application – Go to the Framework




elnvoicing – Why?


