I have been requested by the Minister for Further and Higher Education, Research, Innovation and Science, Mr. Simon Harris, T.D, to attach a copy of an application received under Section 29 of the Technological Universities Act 2018 (No.3 of 2018).

The Minister, hereby, directs the Higher Education Authority, in accordance with Section 31(1) of the 2018 Act, to nominate at least 3 persons having a special interest or expertise in, or knowledge of, matters relating to higher education, at least two of whom shall have expertise at an international level in standards and practices in higher education for appointment by the Minister to an advisory panel under Section 31(3) of the 2018 Act.

A similar direction has been made to the Qualifications and Quality Assurance Authority of Ireland.

The nominations should be furnished to the Minister at the Authority's earliest convenience but not later than within 60 days of this direction.
