Outcomes

5% were working or due to start a job, 18% were in further studies or training, 4% were unemployed, 3% were in another activity.

Occupation

2% were working in professional occupations, 15% in associate professional and technical occupations, 9% in sales and customer service.

Sector of employment

16% were working in human health and social work, 14% in financial, insurance and real estate, 12% in education and 11% in professional, scientific and technical.
