- Successful POBAL grant application (MIC/ULSU/ETB/MWRDAF) (2015?)
 - Project worker; steering group; working group
 - Project worker position sustained for 2 years
 - Year 2 funded by 3 institutions
 - Steering group dissolved; network group continued
 - Drive initiatives
 - Policy template
 - Coordination by MWRDAF key since the start
 - Different levels of involvement by partners
 - Huge goodwill has kept the network going for 10 yrs

Purpose of the network

- 30K+ students in Limerick during AY
- Regional & collaborative approach (MIC & TUS campuses in Clare & Tipp)
- To provide a forum for discussion of current & emerging issues/ trends regarding alcohol & other drug use relevant to the third level institutions in the Mid-West.
- To identify possible responses to these issues/trends in a cooperative way
- To provide a forum for sharing experiences, knowledge, ideas & resources and disseminating good practice
- Meets 4X/year with smaller task-based working groups meeting more frequently (e.g. race day, drug driving awareness project)
- Funding applications (small grants)

Personal reflections & next steps

- Learning from others (HSE, MWRDAF, AGS, HEIs, SUs, VAs) and sharing knowledge is vital. We cannot work in silos – healthy campus/city/settings approach. We are not in competition. The whole is greater than the sum of its parts.
- Feeding into the Prev/Ed subgroup of the MWRDAF feeds into the regional forum – 3rd level has a voice
- Sharing resources/real time on the ground info
- Next steps:
 - Finish & sustain #drugdrivingaware project
 - Gambling/gaming
 - Cannabis/HHC/Vaping
- Challenges: Time; SUs competing areas of interest

Case study: #drugdrivingaware Developed by students for students

- Context: student commuting, new test administered by the AGS – higher level of detections 2023-24. In 2023, over one-third of DUI detections were attributed to drug driving. Raised as an issue in the network Sept 2023.
- The #DrugDrivingAwareness project is an educational and harm reduction initiative that aims to raise awareness about the issue of Drug Driving and its potential consequences.
- We asked students about their information needs. 6 practical questions.
- Road Traffic Garda interviewed by SU officers 6 videos Insta
 - 42K + views in 2 weeks April 2024
- Bespoke posters based on information needs
- Still active


