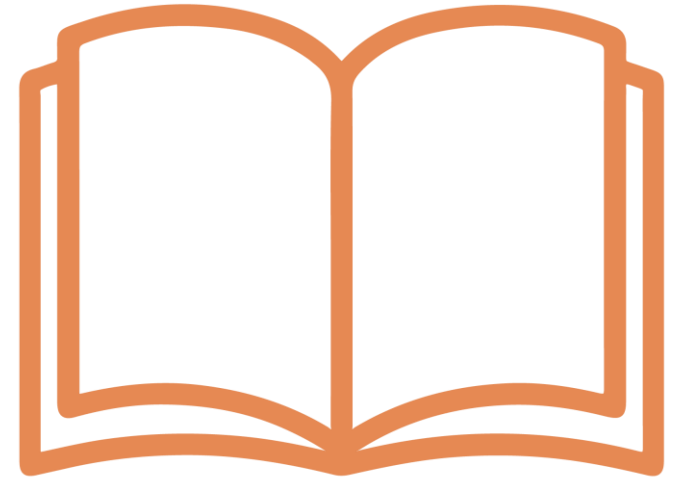

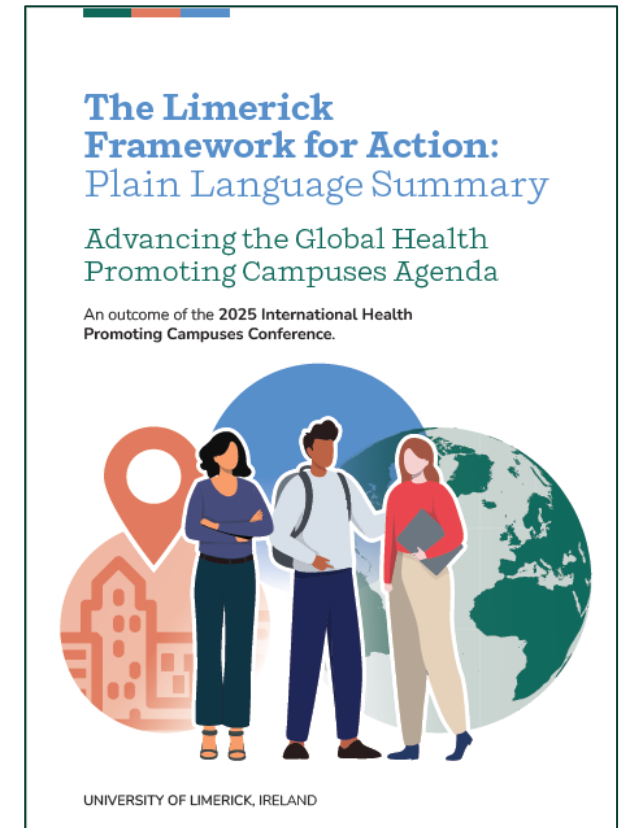
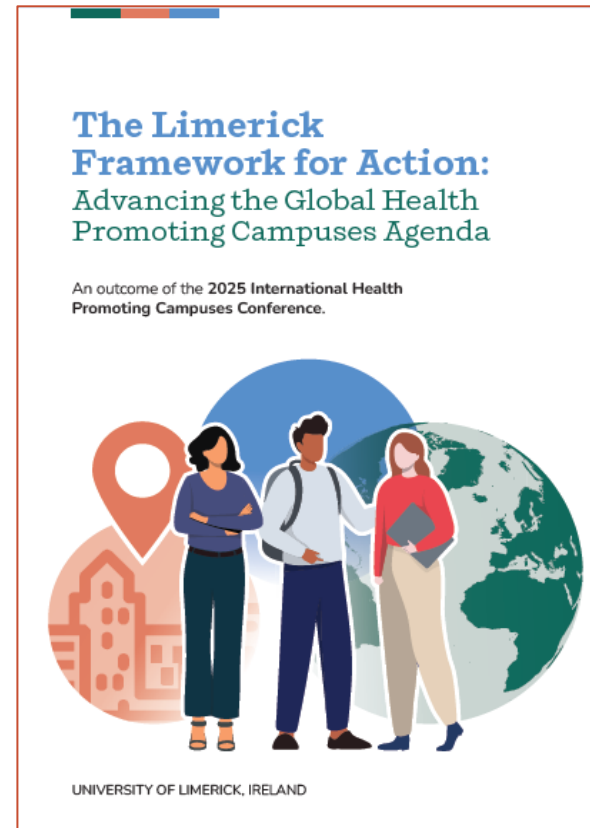

### Step 1: Assess Readiness

- ☐ Identify gaps in policy, culture, and resources.

### Step 2: Build Partnerships

- ☐ Form a cross-campus taskforce.
- ☐ Engage students, employees, and community stakeholders.

### Step 3: Localise the Framework

- ☐ Adapt the 10 Actions to your context.
- ☐ Prioritise equity, Indigenous knowledge, and sustainability.

### Step 4: Embed Health in Policy

- ☐ Apply "Health in All Policies" approach.
- ☐ Audit and align governance, curriculum, and operations.

### Step 5: Activate Culture & Leadership

- ☐ Launch awareness campaigns.
- ☐ Empower student leadership and employee champions.

### Step 6: Measure & Share Progress

- ☐ Define indicators for Planet, Places, People.
- ☐ Publish annual progress reports and celebrate achievements.
